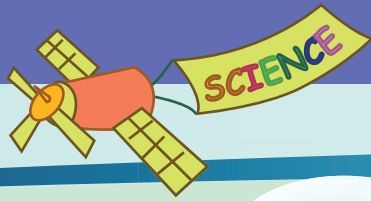

Living things eat and drink.

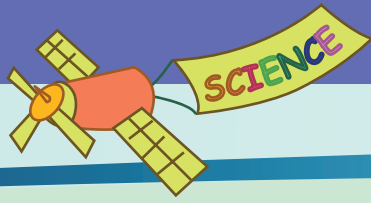


Living things grow.

They **do not** reproduce.

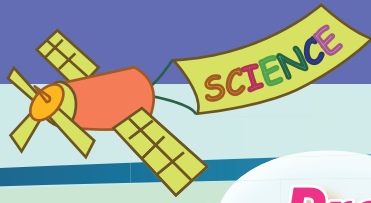

Living things eat, drink, grow, breathe, move on their own, feel and reproduce.

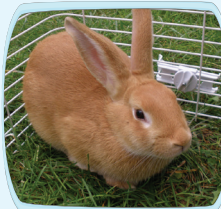


- All of these things are living things.
