Eid al - Fitr

Eid Al - Fitr is a three - day religious festival for Muslims. It follows Ramadan, the month of fasting. The three - day religious festival of Eid Al - Fitr celebrates the end of Ramadan, which is the ninth month of the Islamic Lunar Calendar. During this month, Muslims do not eat or drink during daylight from dawn to sunset. Eid begins with early morning prayers on the first day of the month of Shawwal. During these three days, cities, towns and villages in the Islamic countries are decorated. People put on their best clothes and greet neighbours, relatives and friends everywhere. Eid Al - Fitr is also a time for visiting friends and relatives.

Children usually receive presents or gifts of money from their parents and other relatives.

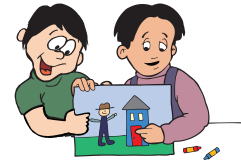

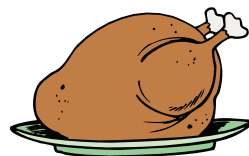
